






## Kansas State Occupant Protection Observational Survey Age 15-17 and Number of Participating Schools




#### The 2018 SAFE Enforcement period took place between February 26 and March 2.


All agencies across the state were invited to participate. Focus was directed toward the primary seatbelt law while state and local law enforcement patrolled around high schools before and after school.





































