**LOCATION OF CLASSROOM TRAINING:** All classroom training will be conducted at the Kansas Highway Patrol Training Academy in Salina, KS.

### **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR COURSE COMPLETION:**

1. The Kansas DRE Program will cover all costs associated with this training, with the exception of meals and lodging during the field certification training in Jacksonville, FL. Meals and lodging will be provided during the classroom portion at the KHP academy dorms and cafeteria.
2. **All students who pass the classroom portion of the course will be required to accompany instructors to certification training in Jacksonville, FL. This training will take place between the dates of March 27<sup>th</sup> – April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023.** The cost of travel (flights) will be covered by the DRE Program. Meals and lodging will be the responsibility of attendees. Lodging information will be forwarded to the accepted applicants as it becomes available.
