Educational Campaign Outline

Intro Event/Assembly: We will have a school-wide assembly on the dangers of texting and driving and the importance of buckling up at all times. After our SAFE group gives their presentation, Sports in Kansas will be doing their "Think Before You Post" program. (sportsinkansas@gmail.com)

Intro Event/Assembly Estimated Date: 9/29/2021

Month 1: We are performing our baseline surveys on October 5 & 6. Then on Friday night, we will announce our survey percentages/results during half-time of our high school football game, along with a short safe driving message for all. Before the game our local sheriff's department deputies will stand at the game entrance with our SAFE members for the Bucks for Buckles program. Each driver who enters the parking lot wearing a seat belt will be given a gold \$1 coin.

Month 1 Estimated Date: October 8, 2021

Month 2: We will do our month 2 activity early, since November has testing dates and December is short. We will recognize Teen Driver Awareness Week and School Bus Safety Week with: *Morning lessons in our CORE classes. We have each teacher present to their class a Google Slide presentation we have created for the topic of the day. We include a real-life video and a quiz at the end. At the end of the week, we have students get on and sign a digital pledge card and give them candy with safety tips taped to them. *We contact our local radio station to participate in their Talk of Emporia radio show. We discuss Teen Driver Awareness week, the purpose of our SAFE committee, etc. *We post daily safety messages on our schools Facebook page to spread knowledge to our family and community members.

Month 2 Estimated Date: October 17-23, 2021

Month 3: We hope to have Miss Kansas give her traffic safety issues presentation this month.

Month 3 Estimated Date: December 8, 2021

Month 4: In January we will invite the sheriff's department for an annual presentation to our junior high and high school student body. They will talk about the dangers of not wearing seat belts and of texting and driving. They will discuss the fees associated with various citations in our county. They will bring the drunk goggles and students will perform an obstacle course wearing them in our gymnasium. We will play a fun trivia game and give away prizes.

Month 4 Estimated Date: January 19, 2022

Month 5: We hope to have ThinkFast visit our school for our February event.
Month 5 Estimated Date: February 23, 2022

Month 6: Our SAFE group will deliver the Booster Rooster program to our students in Olpe Elementary. We have a Pre-K through 6th grade elementary school. We present the Booster Rooster program through 3rd grade, and then we adjust the information and add to it to also present to our 4th-6th grade classrooms as well. Our local sheriff's department has deputies attend and discuss bicycle safety at this time as well. We have seat belt races and play seat belt obstacle courses. The sheriff's department donates items for prizes as well.

Month 6 Estimated Date: March 23, 2022

Final Assembly: We will do our end of year seat belt surveys early this month. After collecting data, we will hold an end of year drawing with all of the monthly seatbelt pledge tickets students have submitted all school year and give away gift cards and hopefully a larger grand prize this year. We also plan to present a mock crash scene presentation in conjunction with the sheriff's department to remind students of the dangers of drinking/driving, texting/driving, and not wearing their seat belts. This will be presented before prom and graduation.
