Prior to joining the Kansas Attorney General's Office as the Traffic Safety Resource Prosecutor (TSRP) in January of 2017, Corey served as an assistant county attorney and a municipal prosecutor.

As TSRP, Corey serves as a resource for prosecutors, law enforcement officers, court personnel, and other traffic safety professionals providing training and responding to requests for technical assistance. Corey chairs the Kansas Impaired Driving Task Force, and serves on the Breath Alcohol, SFST and DRE Advisory Panels as well as other impaired driving and traffic safety related boards in Kansas.

Corey has been privileged to provide training on impaired driving and traffic safety related topics at local law enforcement agencies, regional, and national conferences such as Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD), LIFESAVERS, the Midwest Center for Traffic Safety, the National Association of Prosecutor Coordinators (NAPC), the National Traffic Law Center (NTLC), the Kansas Transportation Safety Conference.
